Ex-POTUS Donald Trump has launched yet another attack on US President Joe Biden, accusing the latter of destroying "the American dream" within a year. Speaking at a "Save America" rally of his supporters in Commerce, Georgia, on Saturday, the 45th American president berated the Biden administration over the Ukraine crisis, high inflation, and soaring gasoline prices, slamming at some point of his speech NBC journo Chuck Todd as a "sleepy son-of-a-b**ch". Trump has repeatedly described Todd, moderator of NBC News's Meet the Press programme, as "sleepy", also slamming NBC as "fake" news channel. Trump has had a longstanding feud with NBC News and Todd, whom he considered to be biased against his administration. The 45th president first used the word in April 2017, when he questioned why Todd and NBC News were not covering his claim that the Obama administration illegally spied on his campaign. "When will Sleepy Eyes Chuck Todd and NBC News start talking about the Obama SURVEILLANCE SCANDAL and stop with the Fake Trump/Russia story?" Trump tweeted at the time. It remains unclear why the former US president singled out the moniker during the Commerce rally. "You could take the five worst presidents in American history and put them together and they would not have done the damage Joe Biden has done in just 15 months. In just over a year he has managed to kill, literally kill the American dream. But do not lose hope because with the right leadership America will be back greater, stronger and more powerful than ever before", Trump argued on Saturday.

He then went further by asserting that the US president "has been one train wreck after another" and accusing Biden of "disgracing" the nation with "his humiliating surrender in Afghanistan" and skyrocketing inflation, which is the "highest in over 40 years".

Trump also pointed the finger at Biden over soaring gas prices, the migration gridlock, and Russia's ongoing special military operation in Ukraine.

"Gas prices are the highest in history. Think of that. And we had them below \$2 a gallon. Think of that, and now it's going up to \$5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10. How high can you count? Our borders are completely demolished. Bloodthirsty criminals are laying waste to our Democrat-run cities. There were more COVID deaths in 2021 that were in 2020 with all the work we did. Who would have believed that? And just when you thought it couldn't get worse, Joe Biden totally failed to deter Russia's disgraceful invasion of Ukraine", the ex-POTUS stated.

Trump argued that "[the] Ukraine [crisis] would've never happened" had he been president of the US now. According to him, America currently has "a president that has no idea what the hell he's doing and has no idea even where he is. The fake news, they're trying to say he's acting brilliantly [...]".

Several lawmakers were left injured in India's West Bengal legislative assembly on Monday when a scuffle broke out between members of the ruling Trinamool Congress (TMC) and its archrival Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) after the latter sought a discussion about killings in the Birbhum district. The melee in the state assembly erupted after BJP legislators demanded the resignation of State Chief Mamata Banerjee, who also holds the portfolio of the state's Home Ministry, over the recent violence in the village of Bogtui. The BJP lawmakers went into the well of the state assembly and chanted slogans against the state chief. Speaker of the legislative assembly Biman Banerjee repeatedly asked the lawmakers to take their seats, but they continued chanting slogans. Following the sloganeering, TMC legislators also came into the well and became engaged in an altercation with the opposition. Following the incident, the BJP's members of the legislative assembly (MLAs) walked out, saying that their lawmakers had been manhandled by TMC politicians on the floor of the house. Five BJP legislators -- Suvendu Adhikari, Manoj Tigga,

Narahari Mahato, Shankar Ghosh, and Dipak Barman -- were suspended for their alleged involvement in the scuffle inside the assembly. Both parties alleged that their lawmakers were beaten up. Sharing a video appearing to show the scuffle between the lawmakers, BJP IT cell chief Amit Malviya claimed that "BJP MLAs were assaulted by TMC MLAs when they were demanding a discussion on the Rampurhat massacre". BJP National General Secretary (Organisation) B.L. Santhosh accused the TMC of causing the ruckus.
