REVEALED: Govt Censorship Tool Aimed at Swinging Election is Funded by Russia Hoax-Linked Billionaire Anti-Trumper.

Public records requests have revealed that a Department of Homeland Security (DHS) initiative aimed at censoring social media users during the 2020 election was funded by hardline 'Never Trump' figure and Biden donor Pierre Omidyar.

Omidyar, a French-born, Iranian-American billionaire founder of eBay, provided money to the Center for Internet Security (CIS) nonprofit to create its Misinformation Reporting Portal (MiRP), <u>according</u> to investigative reporter Lee Fang.

This portal was used by what Fang describes as a "coalition of liberal-leaning research groups," including the Democratic National Committee – and excluding the Republican National Committee.

It operated under the supervision of the Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Agency (CISA) which unlike the CIS itself, is a U.S. government agency answerable to the Department of Homeland Security.

Content flagged through its portal, "predominantly" posted by conservatives, was forwarded to moderation teams at Twitter and Facebook to be censored, at a 61 percent success rate.

Fang, who collaborated with journalist Matt Taibbi on the "Twitter Files," stressed that his documentation confirms the "CIS and CISA worked together" to flag content, describing the arrangement as a "public-private partnership".

The Never Trump Billionaire.

While accurately described as a <u>major funder</u> of organizations backing Biden's bid for the presidency by Fang, Pierre Omidyar has also put money into well-known "RINO" (Republican In Name Only) groups.

As <u>reported</u> by The National Pulse in 2022, he put substantial sums into the Defending Democracy Together initiative founded by Never Trump commentator Bill Kristol.

Omidyar was also <u>connected</u> to the so-called Real Facebook Oversight Board affiliated with Russia Hoax ringmaster Christopher Steele, funding it via his George Soros-partnered Luminate foundation.

The news is certain to raise suspicions over far left money and it's deployment in the upcoming 2024 election.

"The team of battle-hardened pros he has assembled may be his best hope," writes Washington correspondent David Charter. Another top staffer mentioned is strategist Chris LaCivita, a former marine with a wealth of campaign experience.

The article also lavishes praise on Jason Miller (former War Room, GETTR), as well as comms impresario Steven Cheung, social media chief Dan Scavino, and lawyer Boris Epsteyn.

Alex Conant, a former political strategist for U.S. Senator Marco Rubio, told <u>Axios</u> Trump has "hired some real professionals and understands that the only way he wins the nomination for a third time is by running a very disciplined campaign."

Trump's team has already begun to rally against the 37 felony counts revealed on <u>Thursday</u>, June 8. Of the Department of Justice, which is responsible for bringing the charges, Trump <u>argued</u>: "This is a sick nest of people that needs to be cleaned out immediately."

Nicola Sturgeon, the former First Minister of Scotland and leader of the Scottish National Party (SNP) has been arrested as part of an ongoing investigation into the party's finances.

Sturgeon is perhaps best known in the United States as a onetime foil to Donald Trump and his Scottish golf properties. After she left office, the former President declared: "Good riddance to failed woke extremist Nicola Sturgeon of Scotland! This crazed leftist symbolises everything wrong with identity politics."

According to <u>Police Scotland</u>, Sturgeon "is in custody and is being questioned by Police Scotland detectives."

"A report will be sent to the Crown Office and Procurator Fiscal Service," the police added.

The ongoing investigation – known as "Operation Branchform" – is examining potential fundraising fraud within the party, concerns about which initially began in 2017 after a <u>Labour Party member of</u> <u>the Scottish Parliament</u> demanded the Electoral Commission look into whether the SNP was spending fundraising money on political campaigns.

In April this year, Sturgeon's husband and former CEO of the SNP, Peter Murrell, was <u>arrested</u> and spent 12 hours in police custody. That same day, Sturgeon's house and the SNP's Edinburgh-based headquarters were searched by police officers in connection to the alleged offenses.

Trump briefly spoke with The National Pulse and POLITICO on board his private jet before touching down in The Old North State. Asked about how he maintains his combative demeanor, he told the Pulse, "What choice do I have?" after declaring that he would not back down from the huge fights before him.

"They've launched one hoax and witch hunt after another to try to stop our movement and thwart the will of the American People. It's called Election Interference," Trump will say tonight at the North Carolina GOP Convention.

Described by aides as "defiant" in his demeanor today, the 45th President took off from Newark, New Jersey around 11:30am on Saturday, travelling with Georgia representative Marjorie Taylor Greene as well as his closest aides and advisors. He landed to crowds of supporters, walking the line, shaking hands, as fans chanted "four more years!" as well as "we love you." The streets outside the airport were also lined with supporters as the ex-POTUS's motorcade travelled to the GOP convention.

Overall, homicides are 22 percent higher than they were at this point in 2022, and on course to surpass 200 by year's end for the third year in a row.

Prior to 2021, annual homicides had not hit the 200 mark since 2003. In 2020, this mark was just barely missed, with homicides reaching what was then a 15-year high at 198.

The news comes despite the American capital having some of the most stringent gun control laws in the country. Indeed, firearms offenses have only increased in recent years, and are currently <u>up</u> by 40 percent on 2017.

Touted as a "Dangers to Democracy" survey provided to *The Guardian,* the poll asked if a "secret group of Satan-worshiping pedophiles is ruling the US government".
