But 2022 is The Great Reset, literally and figuratively, for Mr. Berry, who is now faced with circumstances he never dreamed possible just seven weeks ago.

## **“Count your blessings”**

Mr. Berry received his first Pfizer mRNA injection on January 7, 2022. We reached out to find out his reasons and motivations to receive the shot.

“I had the vaccine because my family had COVID and I missed 20 days of work,” he told *The COVID Blog*<sup>TM</sup>. “It

caused a financial struggle, and I felt I needed the vaccine to prevent being off work any longer. There was no mandate. I just decided myself that I should do that.”

Just one week after the injection, Mr. Berry reported “tingling in his legs” and also having difficulty with bowel movements. He was in the hospital at least five times from January 15 to 24. But all the scans and tests told him nothing. By January 25, he could only walk with crutches. He was using a mobility scooter by Friday, January 28. The last two days of January are when he knew his life was altered forever.

Mr. Berry was “paralyzed below the nipple line” by February 1. Doctors have been completely useless, telling him that his problem was a combination of having COVID in the fall, and then the vaccine. He’s on steroids and has had blood

transfusions, but nothing helps. In less than three weeks, a healthy, 30-year-old man went from working construction sites, hiking, etc. to being paralyzed and unable to use the bathroom on his own.

Friday 14th had tingling all up my legs, my feet were numb, struggling to go to the toilet. Next 11 days in and out of hospital for hours and hours on end having scans and scans and tests and no answers

Tuesday 25th hobbled in to a neurologist appointment, the next day could walk with sticks, the next with a frame and Friday hired a mobility scooter.

Sunday 30th started falling over at home trying to stand, couldn't use the toilet etc fell over shit myself had to be cleaned and picked up by @wardenoflove.

Tuesday 1st admitted to hospital with no lower body mobility below the nipple line,

Discharged myself Friday as care was so bad, I've had all the tests, all the scans and the consultants have no idea what it is all they can speculate is a huge autoimmune shit storm as a result of having covid in October/ November and then the vaccine fucking with my central nervous system. Only thing left to try is blood plasma transfusions starting Thursday at Oxford

I now can't move below my nipple line, in an electric wheel chair full time. Can't go to the toilet properly, have to be moved in bed every 4 hours so I don't get pressure sores etc. The steroids are awful - the come down hits you like a train. You worry about little advancements and becoming locked in unable to feel anything with your hands. I have no income overnight and trying to navigate the world of benefits ASAP etc

This isn't a anti vaccine post it's a don't ever take anything for granted post! You don't know you'll wake up as you are today, tomorrow! Count your blessings, make the choices that make you happy, believe in yourself and prioritise YOU, this is your warning to strive for happiness in the here and now and live for each day as a block of 24 hours. Choose life, not a 3 piece on credit

Mr. Berry takes full responsibility for the choice he made and blames nobody but himself. His primary concern, knowing he's unlikely to ever walk again, is to maintain the sense of touch in his hands so he can touch and feel his girlfriend.



ru11214 Having felt out of control and vulnerable as hell Over the last few weeks finally a win, I might not have the autonomy over my movement or body BUT I didn't stop advocating for what I wanted which was to engage with any treatment offered on my terms as an outpatient and blood plasma therapy that I was desperate to try.

The aggressive onset and continuing advancement of this mystery illness meant I didn't want to be admitted to hospital any longer, I wanted to experience touch, feel and warmth in my hands and touching my beloved partner @wardenoflove whilst I could. I didn't want to go in and come out with no hand sensation left at all.

None of the outcome affects this win, I chose this, asked for this, and got it on my terms. I made a choice and was listened to.

## Ominous outlook with a smile

Ultimately Mr. Berry was diagnosed with a non-traumatic T1 spinal cord injury. Essentially the mRNA injection poisoned the first thoracic vertebra, [the upper-most bone on the spinal column](#) before the neck bones. That, or blood clots stopped blood flow to that area, killing the tissue.

That area of the spinal cord controls everything from walking and bowel movements, to the sense of touch, including sexual sensation. Non-traumatic spinal cord injuries (SCIs)



make up only [16% of said injuries every year](#). Most of those are caused by cancer, infections or disk degeneration, [according to the Mayo Clinic](#).

Mr. Berry is concerned about how quickly the condition developed and spread. He can talk, move his head, and “stiffly” move his arms and fingers. But neither he nor doctors know if he’ll eventually just be a conscious mind in a body that cannot move at all.

Mr. Berry has been communicating  
with *The COVID Blog*<sup>TM</sup> via voice  
recordings since he has trouble typing.  
Despite everything, you can still hear  
positivity in his voice.

“My outlook is good. I get to be with my best friends all day long,” he said. “Yes things look different, there’s a different path than normal now. But at some point [this condition] will plateau and stop progressing. But until then, I’ll just take it a day at a time.”

## **Pandemic of paralysis**
